ReadyShipper by TrueShip[™] is an advanced order routing and shipping solution. ReadyShipper 4 showcases a clean new interface, featuring fully integrated UPS and USPS shipping.

ReadyShipper is expandable and can be used with a growing number of Modules. Look to the Modules page at www.trueship.com for a cast of plug-ins supporting ShopSite, OrderMotion, QuickBooks, UPS WorldShip and more.

ReadyShipper has been designed to install easily, requiring no additional hardware or technical experience. This guide will walk you through set-up and how to quickly turn a standard order file into completed shipments.

System Requirements

• PC with a Pentium® class processor of 700MHz or higher. Java 6.0 or greater is also required. This is available at www.java.com/en/download/index.jsp.

- 512 MB RAM for Windows® 2000, XP or Vista (1 GB RAM recommended).
- 100 MB of available hard disk space.
- 800*600 display or greater.

Custom Maps

ReadyShipper delivers a versatile mapping system for creating your own maps, or easily loading a map for use with a third party file. Maps are used to import shipping and order data from CSV files or from a database. These maps are small, portable files that can be transferred and loaded into multiple copies of ReadyShipper.

After clicking on the Import Maps button the Import Maps screen will open. This screen is used to view and edit your available maps as well as load a new pre-made map.

Next, click Load Map.
